Writing - Non-fiction

This text exposes children to real facts about people around the world. Read it through with your child then ask them the questions. You will need to scribe for your child although some may feel adventurous and want to have a go at writing themselves.

## Igloos

The word 'igloo' comes from the Inuit word 'iglu'. We say 'igloo' to describe homes made out of snow.

### Who Lives in Igloos?

People from Canada, Greenland (Denmark) and Alaska (USA) used to make igloos. Some Inuit people still make igloos as a shelter when travelling during the winter.



### Fun Facts

1. A good igloo can support a person standing on its roof!
2. Really skilled Inuit people can build an igloo in about 1 hour!
3. Igloos can last forever if it stays 0°C or lower outside.

### How Are They Built?

Igloos are dome-shaped. They are made from blocks of dry, hard snow. A circle of blocks is built on the ground, then more circles of blocks are added. The circles get smaller as the dome gets higher. Ice can be used as a window, animal skins as door flaps and ice and fur as beds.

### How Do People Stay Warm?

Snow keeps the cold out, like a big blanket. Inside an igloo, it can get up to 20°C with a small fire or lamp.

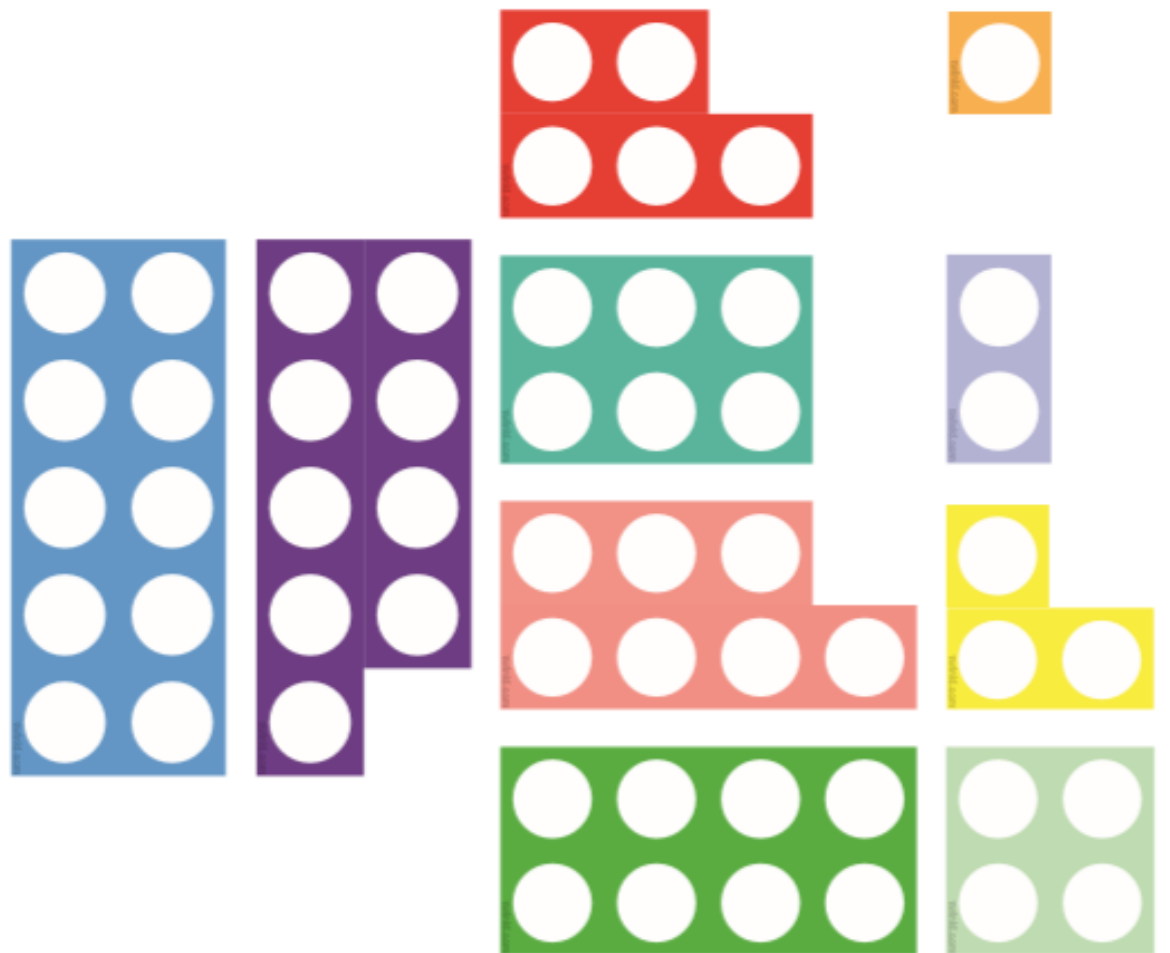
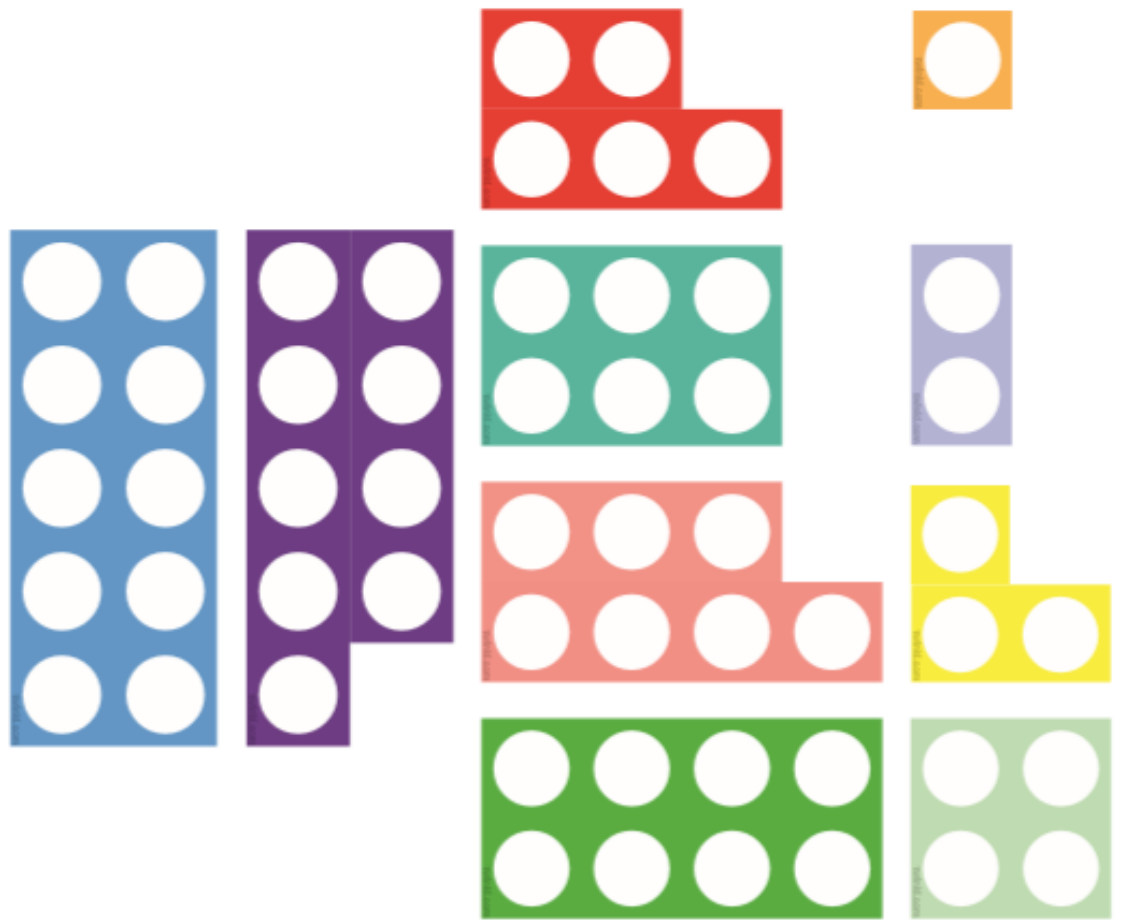
