### Healthy snacks

We continue to strongly encourage only healthy food and snacks in school this term. Children will be awarded a 'healthy house point' whenever they bring healthy food into school for their snacks. It could be a piece of fresh fruit, carrot, cucumber sticks or whatever healthy snack your child prefers. Thank you to all parents and carers for your support with healthy school foods and snacks.

### Self isolation

Since Wednesday 22 December, the 10 day self-isolation period for people who record a positive PCR test result for COVID-19 has been reduced to 7 days in most circumstances, unless you cannot test for any reason.

Individuals may now take LFD tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation period. Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. This also applies to children under 5, with LFD testing at parental or guardian discretion. If both these test results are negative, and a child does not have a high temperature, they may end self-isolation after the second negative test result and return to school from day 7.

Health and social care workers, including those working in education settings, continue to follow guidance for their sector on taking LFD tests on day 8, 9 and 10. For more information, visit [COVID-19: management of staff and exposed patients or residents in health and social care settings](#).

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.
