At Nailsworth C of E Primary School, we deliver a high-quality art education so that pupils are engaged, inspired and challenged.

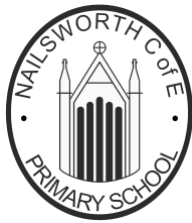
