Religious Education (R.E.) is central to the purpose of Nailsworth C of E Primary School. As a Church school, we see that the Christian faith informs all aspects of our life together and commits us to a search for truth.

## Inspirational

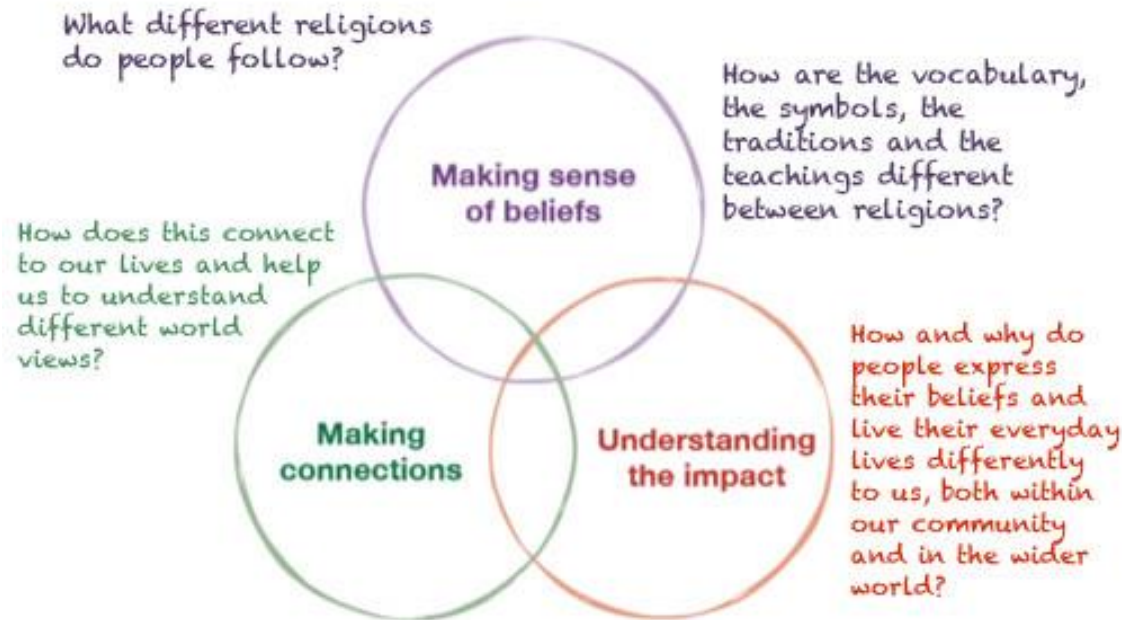

We aim to inspire children, through music, liturgy, stories and reflection time, developing children's appreciation of the variety of traditions, globally.
