Reception

We have been writing our own version of 'Someone Swallowed Stanley', which will be made into a class story book. In maths, we are exploring different ways to make numbers 1 to 10. Today we are going to build sea monsters!

Year 1

We have been learning a poem by Julia Donaldson called 'The Nut Tree'. To help us remember the poem we made up actions and performed them in groups. In geography we have begun exploring our local area using maps and compass points.



Year 2

Year 2 have been learning about the post-impressionist painting, 'The Sunflowers'. It was painted by Vincent Van Gogh. We have been practicing the techniques that he used by using lots of shades of yellow and thicker paint overlaying thinner paint. We will be producing some finished paintings in the next few weeks. We have also been weaving as part of a project looking at textile artists' work. Raphael and Noah have produced some lovely, woven fabric.

Year 3

This week Year 3 had a brilliant time taking part in the Pulse Games. Each team was assigned a country and they competed over the course of the morning in a range of fun, RE based sports activities.

Year 4

In History, we made and played a game from Ancient Egypt called Mehen. In English, we wrote letters, pretending to be Roman soldiers at Hadrian's Wall. In Math's, we have looked at equal and non equal angles. During Guided Reading we have been reading and answering questions about 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' which is our class book.

Year 5

Year 5 have been busy working on DT food designs this week. We are looking forward to cooking some damper bread in our Forest school session on Friday and learnt about the origins of damper bread in the classroom. We have been discussing and working on different belief systems in RE, talking about how different people approach their faith and the impact it has on how we live our lives.



Amber - I really enjoyed English this week, we were using the subjunctive in our writing to make it sound more formal.
