*195 days are defined as "School days". In the school year 2022/23 pupils must attend for 190 days. Schools may decide individually or collectively which 5 days in the year are INSET or non-contact days (days pupils do not need to attend).

Please Note: Schools considering alternative dates or considering changes to their school opening times may wish to contact our Transport Team to discuss transport implications and contact local childcare providers to discuss what impact this could have.

We are moving to cashless!

From September 2022 the school will be moving to cashless payments for meals, trips etc. The move has been prompted by the difficulty and cost of paying in cash to the school's bank account and the increasing ease of making online payments. Did you know that you can use Apple Pay on your phone to add funds to your SchoolMoney account?

Paying by BACS to GCC will no longer be shown as an option for payments to the school as there is a delay of several weeks between the payment being made and the information reaching the school. This can mean that we are chasing for payments that have already been made by parents/carers as we are waiting for notification.

You will still be able to use childcare vouchers for Jigsaw as usual.

The school has a strong record of fundraising for several charities and the children will still be able to bring in cash for these events.
